Gabriel Rodriguez joined Adams County Colorado as the Best and Brightest Fellowship in January 2014. Since then, he has held jobs as the first-ever Cultural Affairs Liaison, Senior Management Analyst and, since November 2019, the role of Assistant to the County Manager.
